Notes on the human energy system

The physical body

It used to be thought that the physical body was in some way animated, governed or directed by an invisible and intangible 'vital force'. Modern physics has demonstrated that the physical form is *itself* energetic in nature, a viewpoint held for thousands of years by, for example, the seers of the Toltec tradition in South America. Therefore, when we speak of the 'physical body' we should be aware that we are actually referring to a particular type of *energy field* which happens to manifest in material form, but which is inseparable from other, less visible types of energy field.

The subtle body

What we call the physical body is that part of the human energy field that is perceptible with the five senses - touch, sight, sound, smell, taste. There are other components of this energy field which are not normally detectable in this way, but which may be detected in other ways. These components include the *biofield* (vital force, life force, chi, qi, prana, ankh etc); the *chakras*; the *meridians*; *kundalini* (the 'coiled serpent); the *aura*; and the *assemblage point*. Each of these aspects of the subtle anatomy have been studied, mapped and documented by various cultures throughout the ages.

The biofield


The human biofield *behaves* like any other field in physics (e.g. electro-magnetism), but it is not identical to any other such field. Research has demonstrated that the biofield has a polarity and flows in consistent patterns. A **peripheral body flow** moves upwards from foot to shoulder on the right side of the body and downwards from shoulder to foot on the left side. These two flows are connected in a continuous stream over the head and around the feet. (**Note:** when fully developed, the loop over the top of the head forms a halo, which may be visible under certain circumstances). A **spinal flow** travels from the perineum, up the spinal column and out through the crown of the head. A further flow circulates through the **arms and hands**. In the majority of people, this flow travels from the right to the left hand, in some cases the direction is reversed.

Emotion centres

At certain sites in the body (called 'emotion regions'), the biofield can be affected in such a way as to produce the *experience* of emotion. Generally, emotions are felt in the front of the body, and in the region of the torso. There are **five emotion centres**, situated at the **root**, **kath**, **solar plexus**, **heart** and **throat** regions.


Emotion centres extend outwards from the associated bodily region. They may be *open*, allowing the associated emotions to be experienced in the body, or *closed*, causing the associated region of the body to be filled with discomfort, contraction or pain. Painful emotions tend to induce an automatic physiological contraction in their associated emotion region, known as the **auto-contractile pain response**. This in turn sets up an area of regional tension which will eventually produce corresponding physiological changes in the local organs and tissues.
